Achievements and performance

Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the year

Charity bank account with Lloyds opened, funds successfully transferred from the (dormant) accounts the charity had previously held with Nationwide Building Society.

Meetings have been held with the Long Rock Residents Association, helping to shape the decisions made throughout the course of the year, and leading to the potential for the parish council to step down as corporate trustee if sufficient number of volunteers come forward from the local community to form a management committee.

The planned demolition of the hall has not been carried out, in response to calls from the community for a new management committee to explore options to retain the hall on site. During the year steps have been taken to maintain the safety of the site.

A grant application for funding for demolition and community consultation was submitted but was not successful.

Overgrown vegetation around the building and on the parcel of land adjacent to the building was cut back to clear the site.

Discussions were held with the local authority and developers, to explore the option for a new-build hall on the site of the Long Rock Memorial Hall, but this did not prove possible.
