Community participation A local resident of Crowlas raised concerns on behalf of them and their neighbours, reporting that the noise and speed of motorbikes along the A30 continues to be a problem for residents. The speaker thought that speed cameras and speed humps were unlikely to help, but that greater police enforcement might help. The noise of the motorbikes, particularly on Tuesday evenings, was very loud and thought to exceed legal limits. A suggestion was made, that the parish council could write directly to the bike leaders to request consideration for local residents.
